The Western Sydney Aerotropolis is set to become a thriving economic centre, building a stronger future for Western Sydney.

Located around the new Western Sydney International Airport at Badgerys Creek, the Aerotropolis will include 10 innovative precincts focused on advanced manufacturing, technology, research, training and education, freight and logistics, agribusiness, and mixed-use development. At its heart will be Australia's newest city – Bradfield City Centre.

As a hub of industry and innovation, the Aerotropolis will attract local and global companies drawn to the enormous potential of the region.

More highly skilled jobs will become available closer to home for all Western Sydney residents. 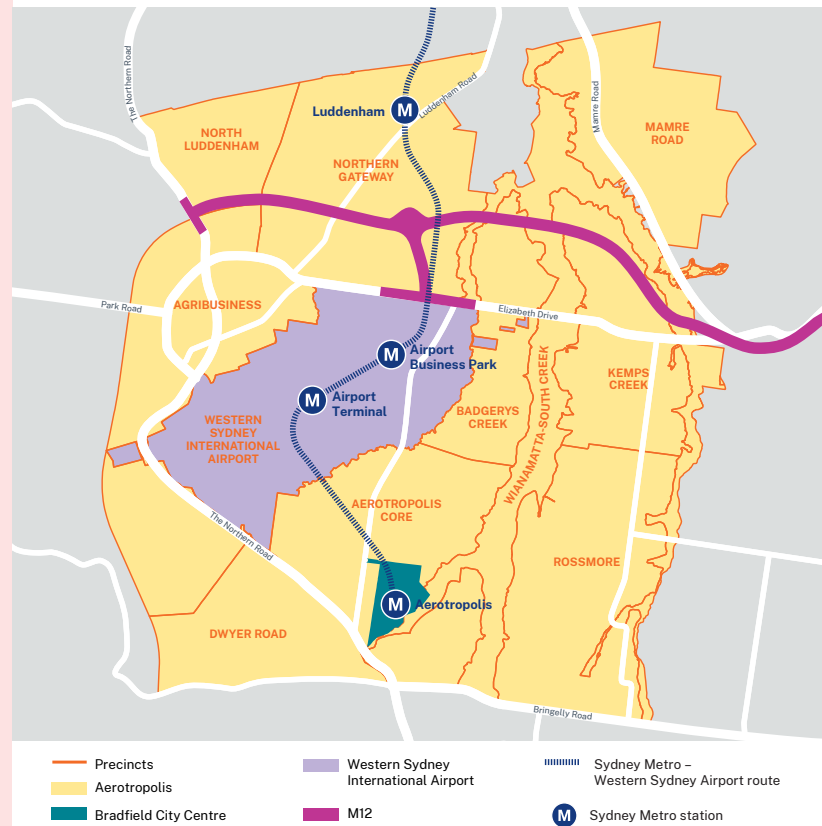
